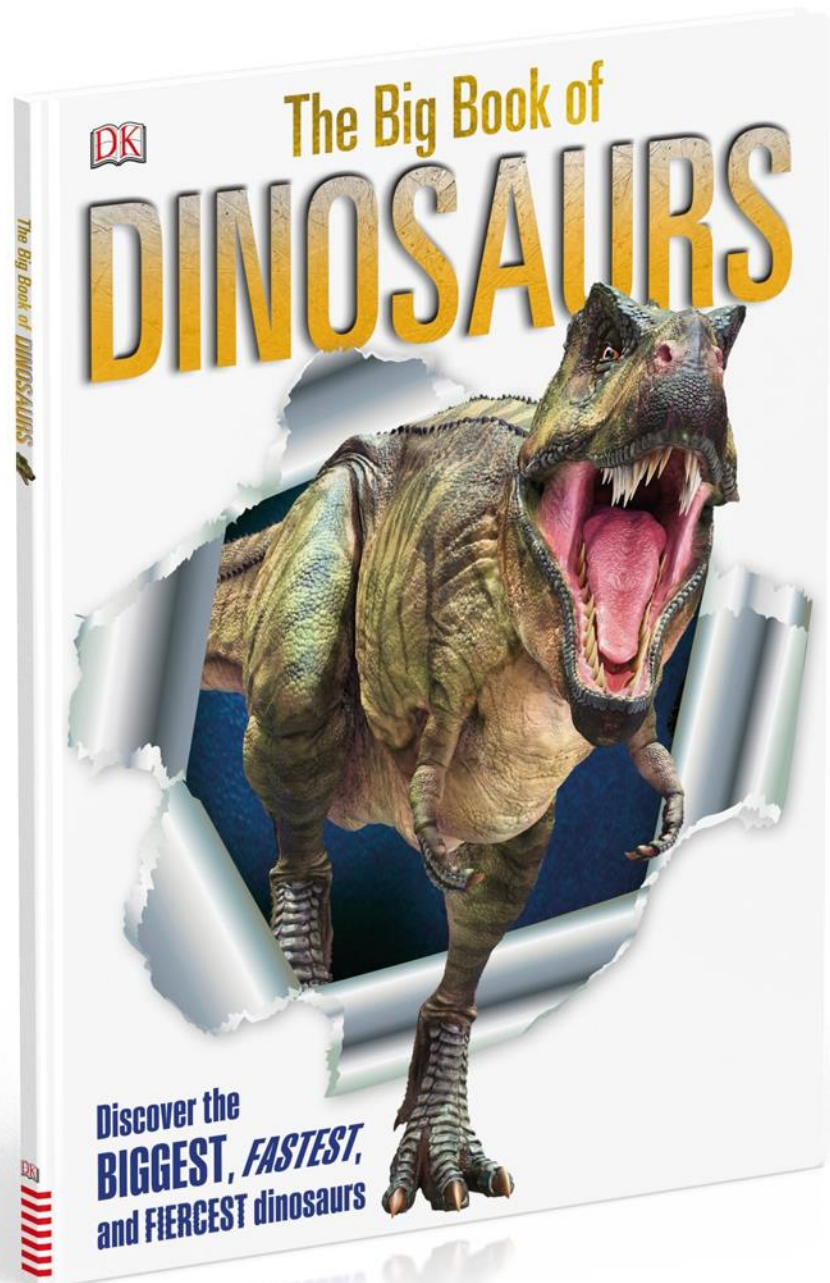


Enough sand (to hold 4 trays or more) and rocks from the beach (Long Island, NY has nice and clean sand).

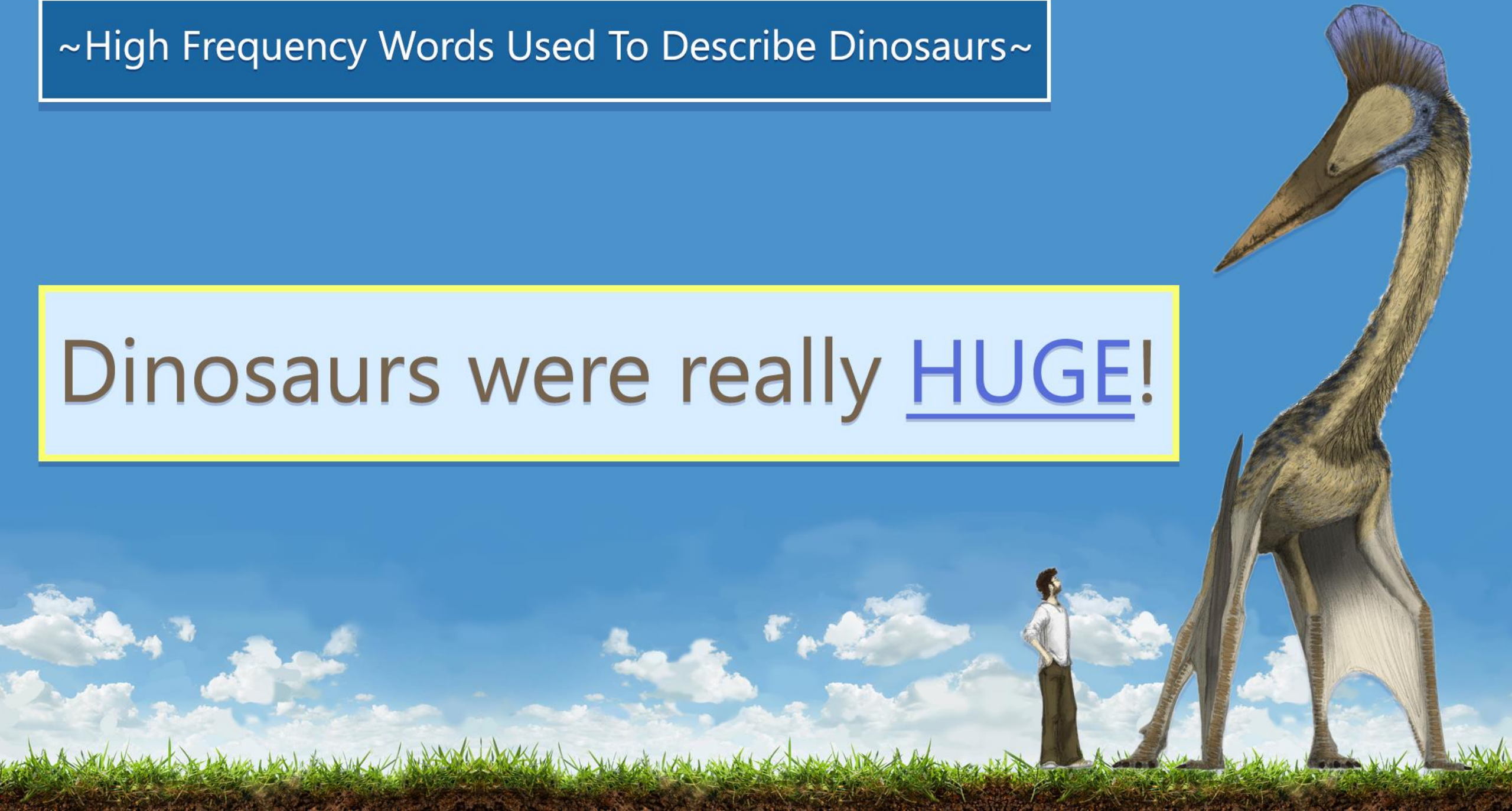


The first thing that our weekend adventures will notice when they enter the classroom is a ambience of jungle background noises with dinosaur roars & footsteps!



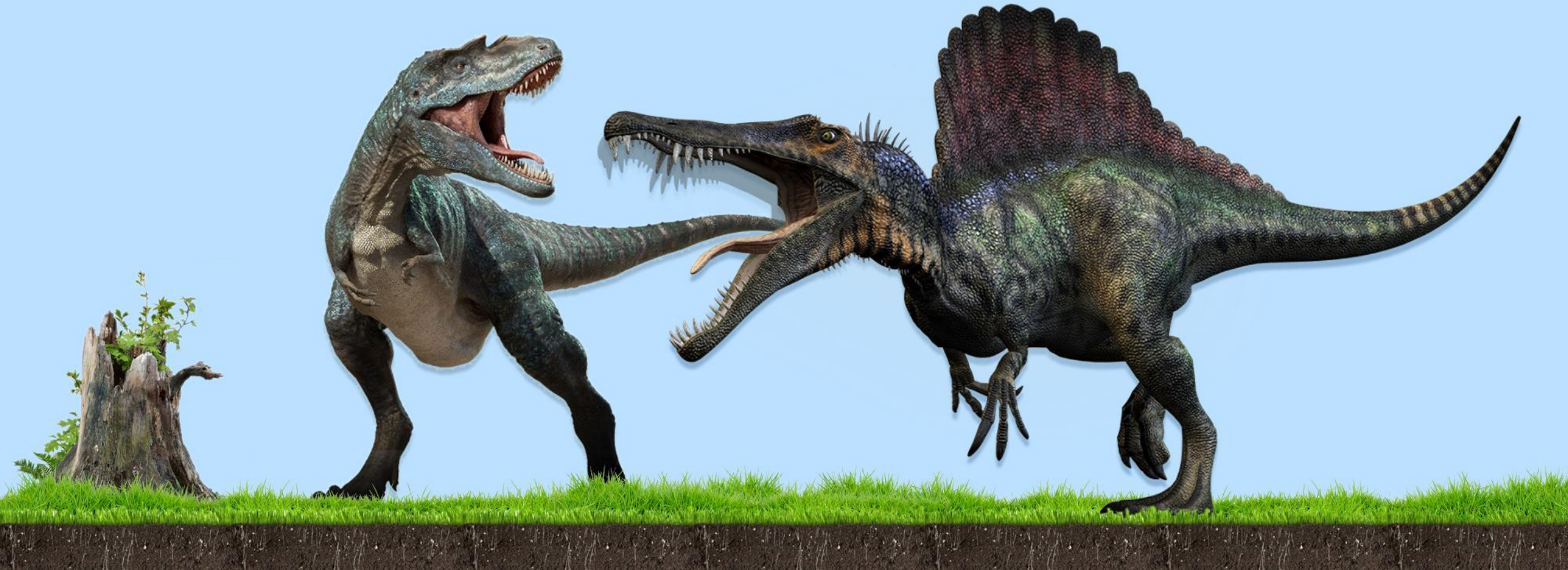

Dinosaurs were really HUGE!

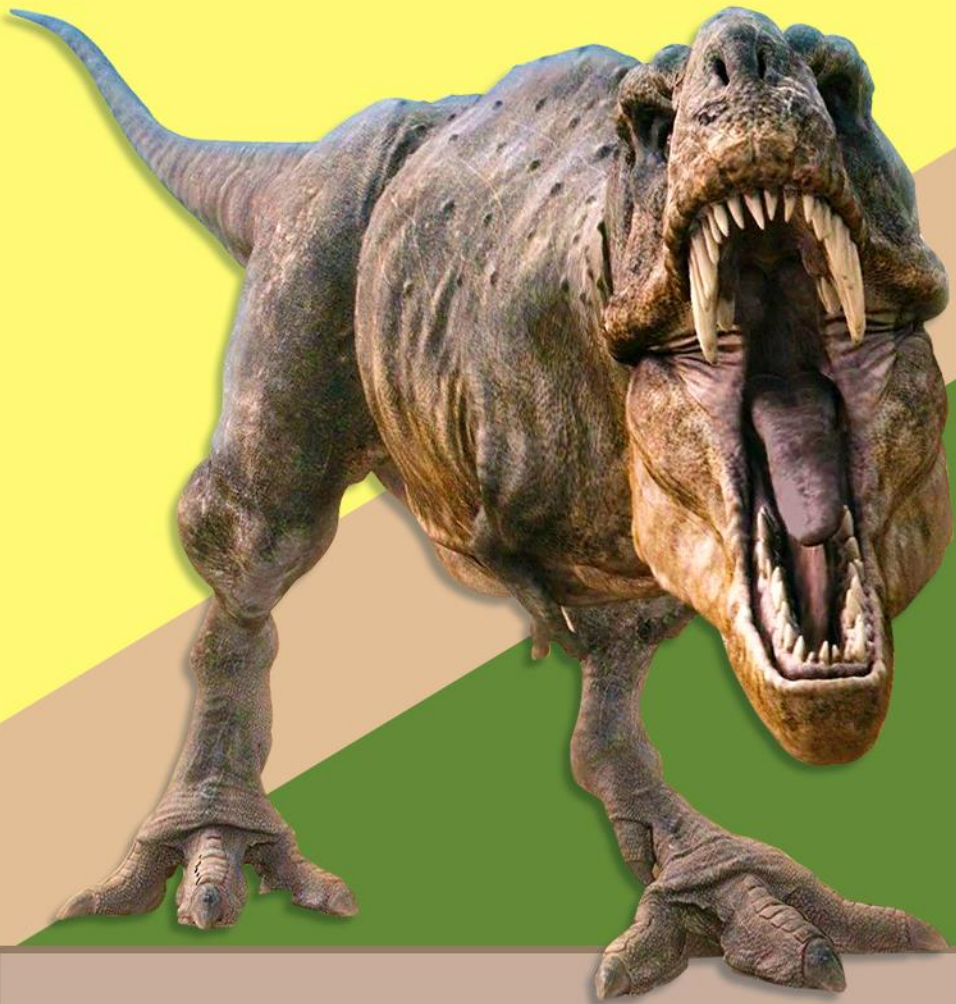




Dinosaurs were SCARY!







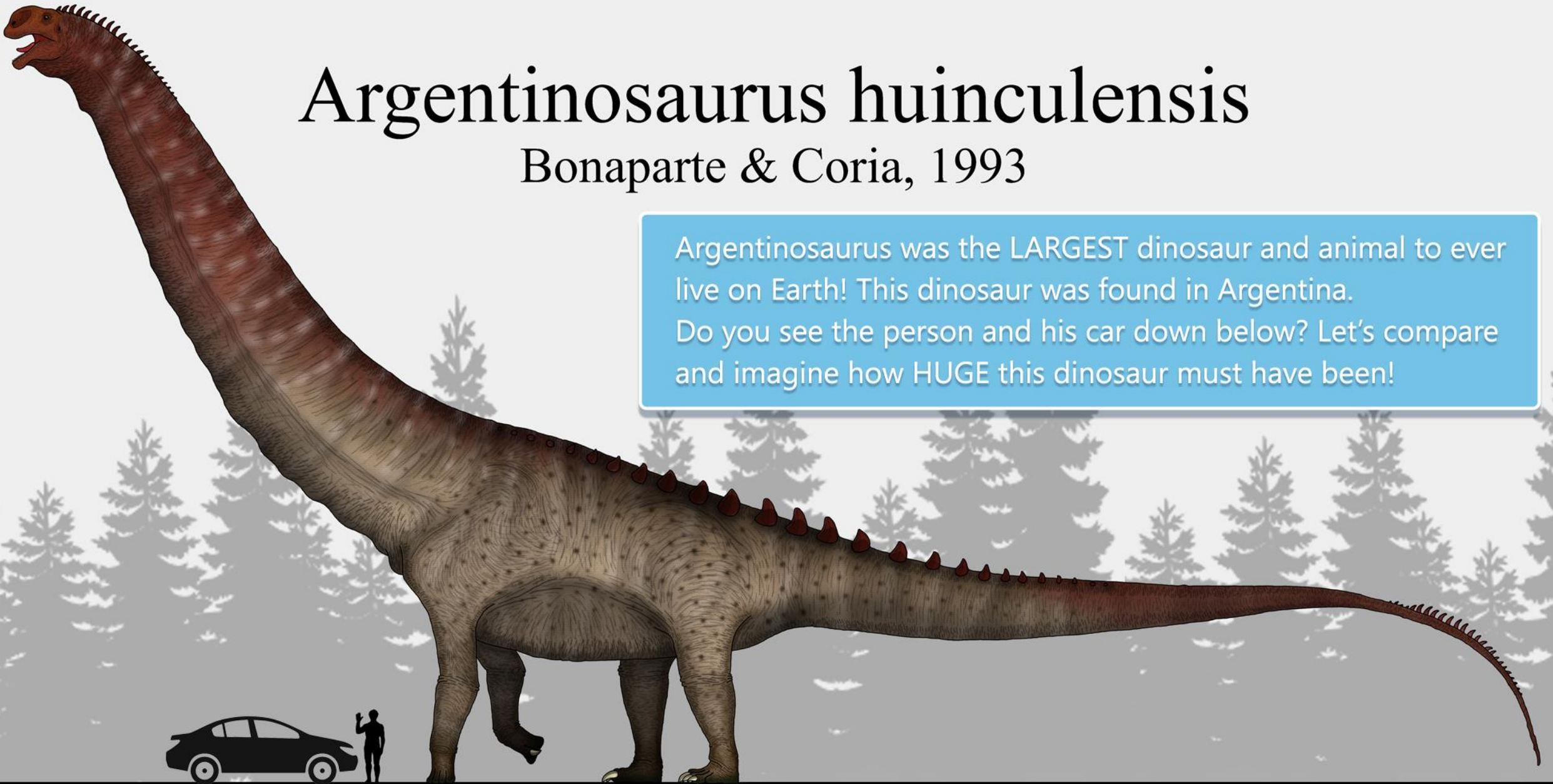

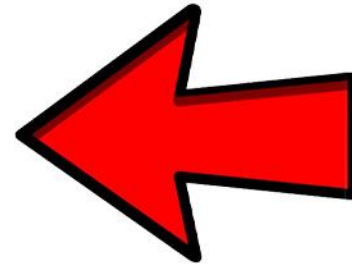
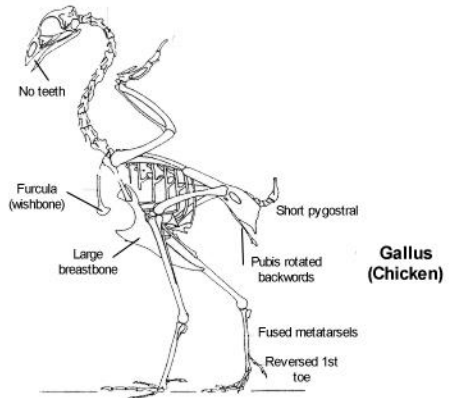
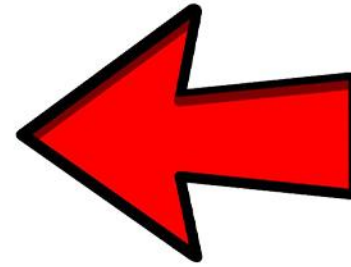
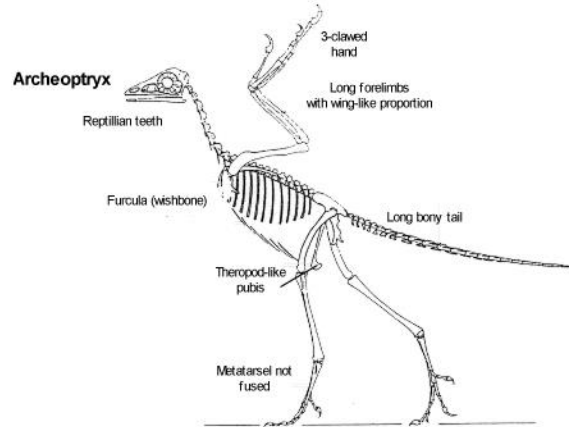
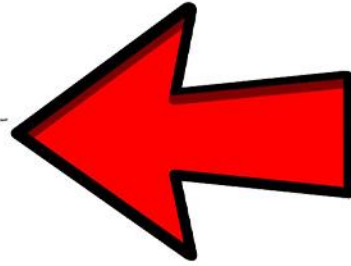
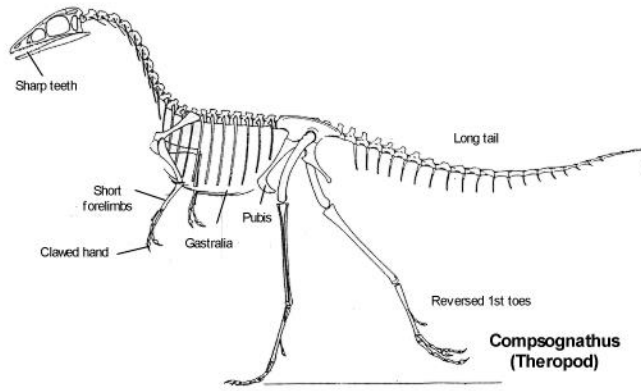




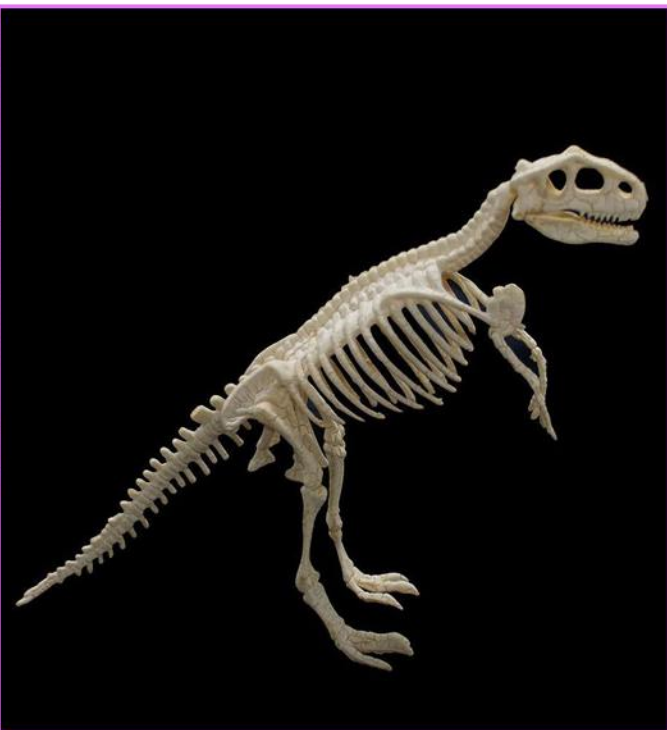


The Blue Whale is still the largest... the heaviest animal... to EVER live, and still live on our planet Earth.

# Adventure Series Project: Dinosaur Fossil Digging

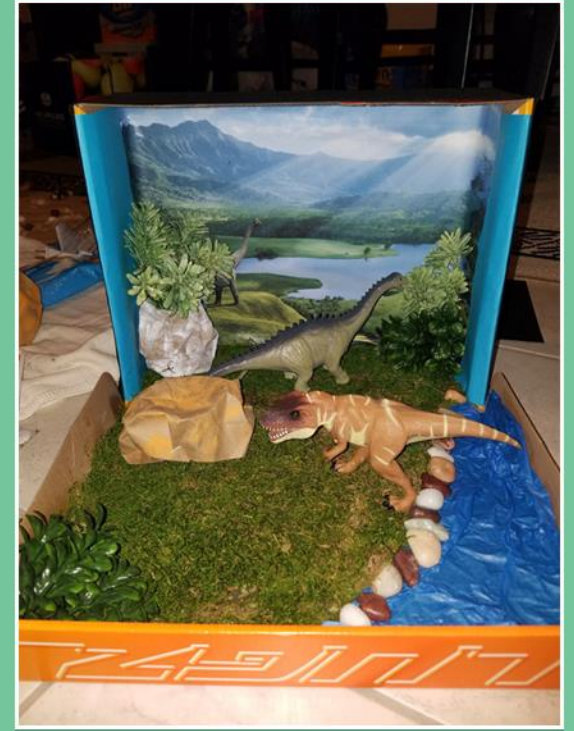




### Adventure Series Project: Discovering Your Very Own Dinosaur Fossils!
