




1. First you will write your name using color markers in a fancy design.
2. Make sure to write your name within the outlines of the house.
3. Next you will cut out the house very carefully.




1. Add about 1 cup of potting soil to the ziplock bag.
2. Be careful not to make a mess!

Then we spray the soil
with water so that it is surely
moist BUT not wet.
Do not make it MUDDY!



1. We add 2 seeds to the soil and make sure they are buried about 1 inch deep.
2. Have them spaced out three inches apart.

- 
1. Tape the bag to the BACK of the Greenhouse.
 2. Try to line up the ziplock to the square cut through of the greenhouse.



- 
1. Turn it around and tape it to a sunny window.
 2. No need to water the soil since the moisture is trapped inside the bag.
 3. The sun heats up the air in the bag much like a real greenhouse.
 4. After about six days, the seed should sprout.



Here is an example of the science experiment with a bean sprouting over four inches! Hopefully with a little luck our beans will sprout too!
